START ACADEMY

This entry level course is designed for young people who love the idea of performing, but may not have had the chance to be on stage before. This course bridges the gap, fast-tracks the audition process and is aimed at confidence building through performance.

SUMMER SCHOOL

This course is designed to inspire and challenge young actors, providing them with the building blocks required to further pursue their acting ambitions. The Bruiser team will be joined by a range of industry professionals to coach and guide participants, holding them to a high standard of practice and providing essential experience and insight into the working world.

GRADUATE ACADEMY

The Bruiser Graduate Academy is an intensive 12-day training course for young adults with a passion for the performing arts, who are serious about their career. You'll get heaps of individual attention from our expert directors, musicians, and choreographers to really hone your skills.





TEACHER REFERRALS

START Academy, aimed at 12-16 year olds, who have little or no experience in performance, and perhaps would not have the confidence to participate in the more intensive summer schools. We are asking teachers to refer students who they think may be suitable for The **START Academy**, to remove the daunting audition process, and encourage participation.

For The **START Academy** we are interested in working with young people who may have specific educational / behavioural needs, low confidence or may be overlooked in performing arts sessions.

You should also know that we are offering a special rate to students for the The **START Academy**, that are referred to by teachers. If a student is referred by a teacher they will get a reduction of 50% on the fee.


